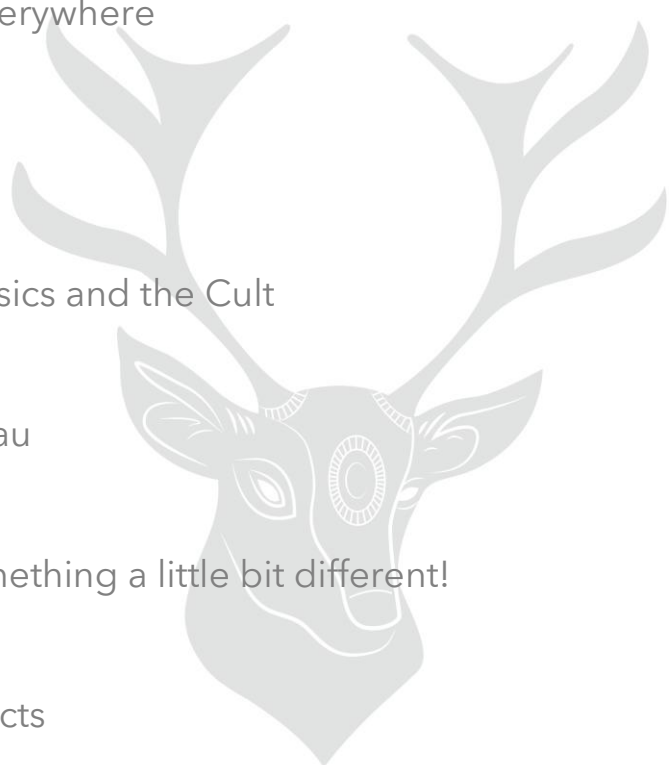

These wines are the epitome of what we love and look for in a wine at Paschoe house; Amazing quality, Hardly heard of Unique wines with distinct character. They also provide a crucial factor for us being; although not cheap, fantastic value. To be able to enjoy a wine of such complexity, length and finesse as the wines of Chateau Simone from more well-known regions you would easily be handing over twice the price.

As such these wines have quite the following but not the wider market appeal to push the price up. Over generations these wines have been crafted by the Rougier family who have painstakingly learnt how to produce sheer excellence from these vines in the Provence.

These are not wines that can be categorised or compared easily to wines of other regions or blends. Although crafted in the honed family way they follow their own rule book which results in a truly special sense of identity and excellence standing aside from the crowd.

Chateau Simone Blanc, 2015

135

Their white which is produced from a blend of Clairette, Grenache Blanc, Ugni Blanc and Muscat is an incredible herbaceous savoury wine. It has great mouth feel and length on the pallet with a lasting fresh finish.

Chateau Simone Rose, 2017

135

This is by far not your classical light floral Provence rose. With approximately 9 months cuvaision this is a rich full berry focused rose. A blend of Syrah, Grenache and Carignan with local varieties provides a true distinctiveness to this beauty of a wine. A wonderful wine which will really open your mind to how rose can be.

Chateau Simone Rouge, 2012

150

This wine is really coming into its showing phase. It produces the depth of hedgerow fruit, earth and gripping tannins but in a rather fine and elegant manner. Truly a wine for those who like to be inspired, surprised and wooed by their tittle. A blend of Grenache, Mourvedre and Cinsault with an array of local grape varieties this wine is truly unique and a joy. Partially aged in Hungarian oak vats this is a wine you will want to keep your tasting notes and share you love with your friends.

Didier Dagueneau

An Eccentric, A Leader, A visionary.

Having been born and raised in Saint-Andelain in the appellation of Pouilly-Fume this is where Didier returned to show to the world the greatness of Sauvignon Blanc. Being highly focused and competitive this is something he has achieved taking his wines to the epitome of the wine world. Using radical techniques for the time and region such as working biodynamically and aging in new oak barrels. His wines are exquisite and balance power, depth and complexity whilst still being elegant. A focus on concentration through low yield and old vines from this small estate (30 Acres) means these wines have very limited availability and as such have gathered a cult following.

In September 2008 it was with great sadness to the wine world to hear that Didier had died in a light aircraft accident in Cognac. His son, Louis-Benjamin, has since taken over the estate and carried on his father's wine making excellence and attention to detail. The wines still consistently bring joy and delight to those who have the opportunity to try them.

They are all true expressions of the terroir they come from and are lucky enough to be truly special microclimates. All with an extremely high clay-siliceous content ensuring the trademark smokiness indicative of the local wines.

Blanc Fumé de Pouilly 2016 **165**

A blend of wines from younger vines across the estate, barrel fermented and aged in half stainless steel and half large neutral barrels.

Pur Sang 2016 **200**

All grapes are harvested from the vines of a minimum of 30 years showing the beneficial effects of deep roots and low yields.

Buisson Renard 2016 **220**

All from vines growing in the Buisson Menard vineyard and the wine so named after a journalist incorrectly named the wine in a review. Very Flinty and mineral-rich from what is considered his best single vineyard.

Silex 2016 **250**

A minimum of 50 year-old vines are used for this wine from soils with particularly high levels of Silex. Matured in large cigar shaped barrels made specifically for the domaine. Rich and powerful whilst maintaining a level of finesse. One of a kind and highly sort after but very limited production. A truly exceptional cult wine.

Les Jardins de Babylone, Jurançon sec, 2014

165 Made with petit manseng from his small estate (3 Hectares) in Jurançon. A very limited number of bottles of the dry wine are made. Racy, elegant and mineral. A highly memorable wine.
